G INTERVENTIONS AND DIVESTITURE

G1. INTERVENTIONS

- 1. The *Bar Standards Board* has the statutory power under Schedule 14 of the Legal Services Act 2007 to intervene into a *BSB licensed body*.
- 2. The *Bar Standards Board* may authorise an intervention into a *BSB licensed body* where:
 - in relation to the *BSB licensed body*, one or more of the intervention conditions (as such term is defined in the Legal Services Act 2007) is satisfied; or
 - 2.2 the licence granted to the *BSB licensed body* has expired and has not been renewed or replaced by the *Bar Standards Board*.
- 3. In circumstances where the *Bar Standards Board* authorises an intervention under paragraph 2 above, such intervention shall be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Legal Services Act 2007.

G2. DIVESTITURE

- 4. The *Bar Standards Board* has the statutory power under Schedule 13 of the Legal Services Act 2007 to make an application for divestiture in relation to a *non-authorised person* and/or a *BSB licensed body*.
- 5. The *Bar Standards Board* may make an application for divestiture if the diveestiture condition (as such term is defined in the Legal Services Act 2007) is satisfied in relation to such *non-authorised person* and/or *BSB licensed body* (as the case may be).
- 6. In circumstances where the *Bar Standards Board* elects to make an application for divestiture under paragraph 2 above, such application shall be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Legal Services Act 2007.
